Many Provinces and Districts have already put in place measures to assist in practical ways like collecting medicines or groceries for those unable to do so. I thank you all for the many initiatives that have materialised over the past few weeks, Truly Freemasonry at work

The announcements last night really hit home to us here in Scotland but Brethren, remember those Scottish Brethren throughout the word in our Districts, under Superintendents and those report directly to Grand Lodge, Many of them are already in lock down and are under the same pressure as we are experiencing here,

Our two Homes are still fully operational. The staff in both Homes are doing an exceptional job under very difficult conditions. Please keep the staff and the residents in your thoughts and prayers
